Final Thoughts

Today, with the explosive growth of the internet, come endless opportunities to earn money from the comfort of your home - writing! Is writing a skill that some people are simply born with, a talent that others can never have? Absolutely not - it can be learned by anyone, and I am living proof of that.

I have only a high school diploma, live in a tiny town of about 3,000 people, and had never written a thing in my life - until three years ago. My life has never been the same since! The internet is the perfect platform if you want to make money writing, without having to write a romance novel or non-fiction book. Short articles, blog posts and website content are in demand, and there are plenty of companies that will pay for your work. I will share those with you shortly!

As you get more familiar with writing for the internet and doing research online, it's quite easy to complete an article in 20 to 30 minutes, and earn somewhere in the neighborhood of \$8 to \$15 and more. In fact, some people are willing to pay \$30, \$50 and more for a well-written article. Would you enjoy earning on average \$20 or \$30 per hour from your own home? I know most people would - and that is well above the wages paid at most jobs outside the home.

Why is there such a huge demand for articles and other written content on the internet? Thousands of people start a new business online every single day; think about this for a minute - what is the internet made up of? Content! Everywhere you look, every website you visit is made up of content. Someone has written every word you find online - so why shouldn't you write some of the content and get paid very well to do it?

You can. At first, it will be a little intimidating but after a few articles you will get past that. I know the first time I put out an ad advertising my services, I was mortified. All I could think of was "What now? What am I going to do if someone responds to my ad and actually wants me to write something"? They did and I did - wrote, that is. Best thing I ever did in my life, and I think you will feel the same way once you get a few articles under your belt. The more you write about and

research various topics, the more confident you will become in your writing skills.

Now, let's get on to business. In this ebook, you will find a list of 30 websites that offer writing jobs or opportunities to write freelance articles on topics that interest you for pay. With most, you simply sign up for an account, submit a writing sample and wait to be approved. Once approved, you have access to writing jobs or get assigned jobs in order to earn money. You will find that some of these companies allow you to submit articles on any topic you like; when someone browses that site and buys your article, you make money!

A word of caution here: Before you sign up with any of these sites, practice on your writing skills. Write a few articles, study some of the articles online to see how other people do it. You can visit sites like www.ezinearticles.com or www.associatedcontent.com and look at articles written about any topic you can imagine!

You also want to remember to write your articles so that they are interesting and offer value to the reader. Write a title that attracts attention; in your first paragraph, summarize the article. This simply means briefly explain what you are going to tell the reader.

In the body of your article, tell them! Expand on your opening paragraph, explaining the who, what, how or where according to the topic you are writing about. Write in your own voice, in a way that is engaging to the reader and not stuffy or overly professional sounding. You want to write articles using a voice that you would enjoy reading yourself, so don't try to sound like a Professor of English.

Okay, let's get started!

Make Money Writing! The Websites

Below you will find a list the websites where you can sign up to become a writer at no cost:

[Constant Content](#) - With Constant Content, you can write articles on any topic you like. Submit your article and set your own price. If a client browsing Constant Content sees your article and purchases it, you earn 65% of the price you set - Constant Content gets 35%. I have sold articles on this site for \$65. You get paid at the first of each month for any content sold the previous month. Clients can also request you to write for them if they like your writing style. Very strict on grammar, but the pay is exceptional.

[Interact Media](#) - Interact Media posts available jobs on the job board. These jobs are first come first serve; if you get to the job board and take the job before someone else gets it, it's yours. Interact Media sends you an email when new jobs have been posted that match your writing profile. If a client likes your work, they can request you for additional articles. On average you will earn \$7-\$12 per article, and you get paid twice per month.

[Content Divas](#) - Content Divas posts available writing jobs on a Write Board - if you beat other writers to the jobs you get assigned the job. Content Divas sends you an email notifying you that new writing projects have been posted. Some projects on the site are recurring, meaning you write for a client every month. Content Divas pays quickly, usually within 2 to 3 days of completion of project. Average pay works out to just over \$9.00 for a 500 word article. Most of the time you will have 10 or more articles included in a package; work must be turned in on a timely basis, usually two 500 word articles per day on any particular project.

[Elance](#) - Elance is a fee-based subscription website that posts writing, website design and programming projects as well as administrative support, sales, marketing, finance and management positions. There are two types of memberships, basic and select. After becoming a member you are allowed to bid on projects

posted from companies or individuals needing freelance work completed. As a member you are allowed to create a profile page that can include your resume, references and clips. This would allow clients the opportunity to contact you directly.

[Article Content Provider](#) - This site pays \$10 or more for articles, not certain when they pay . Article Content Provider prefers experienced writers, so you may want to work with other sites first and build up your portfolio before applying with this site.

[Demand Media](#) - At Demand Media, you get paid weekly for the work you do. Once approved, you simply search within the categories you are interested in, and claim titles you want to write about. You then have 7 days to submit the article, which will be reviewed by an editor. Once published your payment is processed.

[Writer Access](#) – With writer access, you sign up for free. Complete client assignments, and get paid according to your level or rating which is decided based on the quality of your work. Pays the first week of every month for all work completed the previous month through Paypal.

[Xomba](#) - With Xomba, you sign up for a free account and submit articles on your favorite topics. Xomba offers guides for beginners, advanced and expert writers to help them make more money!

[Be a Guide at About.Com](#) - About.com is often looking for contributing writers to write articles for topics that are needed on the site. You will go through a training program in which you submit writing samples to an editor on the About.com site. Once approved, you are guaranteed minimum pay of \$500 per month for the first year, as long as you submit 12 articles per month. You have the opportunity to make much more if your content is good!

[oDesk](#) - oDesk has many jobs available, many for those like you who want to write. Sometimes you may find full time writing work with an employer. Pay rates vary, of course, based on the type of work, your skill level, work history and reputation. Check out what other contractors with similar skills are charging, and price yourself accordingly. New contractors (as a writer, you would be a contractor) often find it effective to price themselves a little below the average market rate at first, until they've landed the first few jobs that will give them the work history and feedback that can make it easier to find jobs at a higher pay rate.

[Go Freelance](#) - Go Freelance offers all kinds of freelance writing opportunities. Pay \$7 for a 7-day trial membership; if you do not find any writing jobs to your liking in the first week, cancel your membership. This company has been around since 1998, and has a good reputation. Pay rates vary.

[Textbroker](#) - Textbroker offers writing assignments based on your writing skills. When you sign up, you will be required to submit a sample article so that your skill level can be rated on a scale of 2 to 5, 5 being the best. You will then be able to choose writing assignments according to your rating. Textbroker pays on the 6th and 21st of the month directly in to your Paypal account.

[The Content Authority](#) – The Content Authority pays you to write articles for their clients who need content; how much you earn depends on the “tier” or writing level you achieve (this is based on quality of work). Pays weekly for completed articles through Paypal.

[Daily Article](#) - Daily Article is easy to join, and no sample article is required. Just sign up and start submitting articles on your favorite topics. Set your own price; when someone browses the Daily Article site and likes your article enough to buy it, you make money.

[Article Sale](#) - With Article Sale, you simply sign up, give your Paypal address and start submitting articles. Like Constant Content and some of the others, when a

potential buyer browses the Article Sale site and buys your article, you make money
- set your own price.

[eCopywriters](http://www.ecopywriters.com/center) - eCopywriters offers projects to writers, paying various amounts for articles and other content according to your skill level and writing ability. 10 levels of writers; on average, writers earn \$20 to \$25 per hour working on basic writing projects. Learn more at <http://www.ecopywriters.com/center>

[RightCopyWriter](http://www.rightcopywriter.com/careers.html) - To sign up with RightCopyWriter, submit the form at <http://www.rightcopywriter.com/careers.html> along with your resume and a sample of your writing. Not sure how much this site pays, but it won't hurt to sign up and find out!

[Freelancer](http://www.freelancer.com) - Freelancer.com is free to join - just sign up and start bidding on available writing projects! This company pays out weekly for completed projects to your Paypal, Moneybookers and wire transfer.

[Online Writing Jobs](http://www.onlinewritingjobs.com) - Online Writing Jobs offers hundreds of various writing jobs. You place a bid on the work, if your bid wins you get paid for doing the job.

[Seed](http://www.seed.com) - Seed allows you to make money in two different ways. You can submit articles on topics you are passionate about and make money, or you can submit your work to a request for content. This is a great site for those passionate about certain topics!

[Break Studios](http://www.breakstudios.com) - Break Studios pays \$8 for each article you write that is accepted; the company pays through Paypal twice each month for work completed. When you sign up, you will be required to submit a resume along with a few writing samples. Once approved, you can claim up to 10 articles to write per time.

[SEO Service Provider](http://www.seoserviceproviders.com) – SEO Service Providers hires writers to write articles and

website content. Simply apply at <http://www.seoserviceprovider.com/contentwriterjobs.html>.

[Helium](#) - Helium is one of the most popular sites that pay for articles. It is also free to sign up for Helium. How do you earn from Helium? You can earn cash from Helium through upfront payments, revenue shares and writing contests. The higher the ranking of your articles, the more money you can earn. And to maximize your earning potential, you have to write as many good quality articles as you can.

For all of the sites listed above, be sure to read submission guidelines as all companies have their own rules and guides for writing. Also, DO NOT COPY from any of your research resources! Write your own original articles, as these sites will use Copyscape or other software to ensure against plagiarism (copying someone else's work).

Most clients and content sites like those listed above prefer a 12 point font, usually Arial or Times New Roman. If you cannot find any information about this is the submission guidelines, email the client or content site and ask.

The best thing you can do if you really want to earn good money is to write for several of these companies. The more you write and the more sites you write for, the more money you will make. If you just want to earn an extra \$50 a week, you can; or, if you want to make a full-time income or more, that's possible too. Your success hinges on how much you want to work, and how much effort you put in to writing good content.

Tips for Getting Your Own Clients

One easy way to get started with your writing is to write about what you know and then approach website owners. People who have online businesses are always looking for fresh new content and articles; this helps them attract new visitors and helps with search engine ranking.

Here is an example of what you can do:

Say for instance you enjoy fashion, gardening, fishing or electronic games. It really doesn't matter what it is; if you like it and can write about it, do it.

Once you have completed a few articles and feel they are of good quality, do a search on Google (or any search engine) for websites related to your topic. For example, if you wrote about the best lakes for fishing, rods and reels or any topic related to fishing, key in fishing supplies, best lakes for fishing, or keywords that will find websites related to your article.

At this point, you want to contact the owner of the website and offer your writing services. Let them see your work, or even offer the article for free if they like it.

Website owners want good content, and when they see that you are capable of writing informational articles chances are they will hire you to write more for them.

Make a point each day to go down the search results and contact at least 3 websites - you can usually find their email address on a "contact us" or "about us" page. If you have several topics or interests you enjoy writing about, follow the same instructions as above, looking for relevant websites that could use your content. The more topics you write about and the more people you contact to offer your services, the more work you will get!

Once you have someone who wants you to write articles, you can either set your own prices or negotiate with them. A good place to start if you have no idea is to charge .02 to .03 per word, which would be \$8 to \$12 for a 400 word article. As your confidence grows and you gain experience, you will probably want to increase your rates gradually.

Later on in this ebook I will give you a few samples of my writing; this will help you understand how much of the content on the web is written. If you want to start your own writing business like I did, the sky is the limit when it comes to how much you can earn! My first month online, I made \$1,600 - which is far more than I expected to make, given it was my very first attempt at writing articles.

Today, I earn on average \$3,200 monthly and I've been at it for just under 2 years. In October, I earned over \$4,000 which really blew my mind. I know that isn't near the \$10,000 or \$20,000 some people claim to make online, but it's a good living for my neck of the woods. The great thing about starting your own content writing business is that you can choose your own hours and charge your own rates! I love it, and thank God every day that he gave me this opportunity.

Now, if you do decide you want to write articles for online business owners who need content, there are some things you will have to get familiar with - but don't worry, I'm going to explain it all to you in simple language so that you will be an expert in no time!

Here we go:

Understanding Keywords

First of all, those people who have online businesses want their website found; after all, if nobody can find it they aren't going to make any sales! Think about the times that you go online looking for information, how to do something, or a product you are thinking about buying. What do you do? You key in "how to lose weight" or "affordable jewelry" or something like that - you get the point.

Those words or phrases that you key in are known as "keywords", a term you are going to become very familiar with if you start writing for online business owners. These are the words that online business owners want used in their articles, on their website pages, blogs and in other content. Why? Because that is how search engines like Google and Yahoo find them in order to rank their website in the search results listings.

Okay, so now you are asking "Why do keywords make any difference to me as a writer?" Whether you write for some of the sites mentioned previously that supply content to online business owners or decide to start your own writing business, those you write articles for will usually want articles written using specific keywords. When they want an article optimized for "affordable jewelry", you want to use that keyword phrase in the title. Here is an example:

Affordable Jewelry That Looks Expensive and Sparkles As Brilliantly as the Best

The customer will usually tell you how many times they want the keyword used in the article; if they do not, I generally include it one time for every 100 words. For example, if you have an average 400 to 500 word article (which is a common

length), you would use the keyword phrase in the article body 4 to 5 times. I normally include 4 to 5 paragraphs in articles of this length, so I will put the keyword in once per paragraph. Make sense?

Other than content, keywords are what make the world go round (at least on the internet). This is how search engines find the information people just like you and me are looking for when we surf the web!

How to Write Good Articles

Writing good articles is not limited to those who were born with the ability to write; with practice, anyone can develop their writing skills and write great content! Remember, you're not writing a novel or trying to win literary awards - articles are just short pieces offering information, written in an easy-to-understand manner. Here are a few guidelines to help you write articles that others enjoy reading:

- Write an attention-grabbing title – The title is the very first thing a reader will notice! If it's dull or boring, they probably won't read it. Capture their attention with a great title, and the battle is half won.
- Write short paragraphs - Never write a 400 word article in one continuous paragraph! When you break up the paragraphs, it makes it much easier for the reader and helps them understand what they are reading. Keep paragraphs to about 70 or 80 words, and try to avoid using sentences that are too long (something I'm guilty of myself – I tend to get wordy).
- Make the first paragraph compelling - A great first paragraph makes the reader want to learn more; include a "hook" of some kind, maybe a question the reader is looking for answers to. This will entice them to read the rest of the article.

- Give the reader what they want - When writing the main body of your article, offer tips and information that help the reader in some way. Your goal is to expand on the first paragraph, giving the reader the information you promised in a way that is clear and easy to understand. Use a numbered list or even bullet points if it helps to make the article easier to understand.
- Check spelling and grammar - What you do NOT want is an article with misspellings or grammar errors. There are many free programs online that will check this for you, so that you can make corrections. Also be careful with the use of words like there, their and they're, or your and you're, making sure you use them in the right context.
- Practice, practice, practice – You know the old saying “practice makes perfect” – it’s *true*. Practice on your writing constantly. Write articles on your favorite topics (or research a few you know nothing about) and submit them to Ezine Articles. While this will not help you make any money, getting your article accepted by Ezine Articles means that it is a decent article.
- Choose the right tone for your articles – If you are writing about a serious topic such as heart disease or cancer, use a more serious tone of voice in your writing. If you are writing about fashion or shopping, an upbeat tone is perfect. It’s good in most cases to inject a bit of your own personality in to your writing, so that it doesn’t come across as dull or bland.
- Don’t include a lot of “fluff” in your articles – Keep your writing on topic. Readers love articles that offer them the information or details they are looking for in a concise, well-written manner.
- Find a pattern that helps make your writing easier. You may want to create an outline on paper so that you can visually “see” how to lay out your article. When you find those articles online that attract your eye and capture your attention, make a note of how they are laid out. Some people use numbered or bulleted points to demonstrate the points they are making.

How to Write Articles Quickly

While you always want to write the best quality articles possible, you also want to do it as fast as you can; after all, this will be your bread and butter! At first, don't be surprised if it takes you an hour or even two to write a single article. You are learning, just as you would with any other job. It won't be long before you can do it in your sleep!

In order to make good money, you want to write at least two articles per hour. At a rate of \$10 or \$12 (which is common for a 400 word article), you would be making \$20 to \$24 per hour. Depending on how easy the topic is or how familiar I am with it, I can sometimes write three articles in an hour, so you see article writing can be extremely profitable.

Here's how to write your articles with lightning speed:

1. Don't over-think things. You need a good title, an introduction, the main body, and a conclusion. Don't try to over-complicate the process; writing articles is pretty basic.
2. Keep your title in mind. Your article **MUST** inform the reader about what the title promises! If you have to, put a sticky note on your computer with the title so that you can keep it in mind as you write.
3. Cover three points in your article. This makes writing your article so much easier. Decide on three points you will write about. For example, if you are writing about "dog training", talk about 3 main areas such as using treats to train, tone of voice, and length of training sessions.

4. Summing it all up. Here it is in a nutshell: To write articles quickly, come up with a good title, an introductory paragraph that briefly describes what your article is about, expand on three points briefly, then a paragraph that concludes your article (basically, this just sums up what you have written). That's it!

5. Write article titles first! In order to write 10 or 20 articles in record time, come up with your titles first. For many, the title is the hardest part to write. Think up your titles, write them down, and then you're ready to go from one to the next without stopping to decide on a title for the next article.

6. Develop your own outline or style of writing. If it makes it easier, create an outline and keep it next to your computer. This outline should include your introductory paragraph, body of your article expanding on first paragraph (or numbered lists if that method is easier for you), closing or summary paragraph.

You will find that the longer you write, the faster you will get. Don't let your first few attempts disappoint you! Every writer goes through those beginning stages when it seems like it just isn't as easy as you thought it would be – but practice makes perfect.

Sample Articles

Here are a couple of articles I have written for you to give you a general idea of how to write for web customers. Most of the websites I have given you above that allow you to make money have their own rules and guidelines. Just follow the instructions set forth by each site.

The sample articles below will demonstrate how to use keywords in your writing, how to create an introductory paragraph, and how to write the main body of your article as well as the closing paragraph. Keywords are highlighted in yellow so that you can clearly see their use.

Sample article #1

(Title) The **Fastest Way to Lose Weight** Includes Real Foods - Forget Counting Calories!

People often mistakenly believe that the **fastest way to lose weight** is to cut back drastically on calories, or to fast and not eat anything at all. Sure, you will lose a few pounds quickly - but it won't be permanent, and your body will likely suffer for it. There is an easy, healthy way to lose all of the weight you want to lose without ever counting a calorie, taking a diet pill or eating a pre-packaged diet meal, and it involves REAL, ordinary food.

You may not realize it, but food is your friend. The problem is, you don't know how to eat it in a way that turns your fat-burning hormones on so that your metabolism works at its optimum level. The truth is, most people can lose 8 or 9 pounds in only a couple of weeks without depriving themselves of real food - the secret lies in knowing how this works.

Think of all of the diets you have tried before. If they did not work then, why would they work now? In all honestly, when you try the same things over and over again you usually get the same results, and that's not working for you.

The **fastest way to lose weight** involves:

Eating foods in certain combinations and at certain intervals, so that your body produces more fat-burning hormones.

"Calorie shifting", which simply means that you switch up the foods you eat regularly, so that you are eating different types of calories; this "tricks" your metabolism in to burning fat and calories continuously.

Eating more instead of eating less. As crazy as it sounds, your metabolism needs food in order to work efficiently. Food is the "fuel" for your metabolism. When you drastically cut down the number of calories you consume each day (which means eating less), your metabolism compensates for this reduction in calories by slowing down - which means less weight loss.

It should be a huge relief to those who have tried everything under the sun to know there IS hope, and that the **fastest way to lose weight** does not involve starvation, dangerous diet pills or eating carrot sticks...

Sample article #2

(Title) **Natural Cures for High Blood Pressure** - Hypertension Can Be Controlled Naturally

Hypertension is known as the "silent killer". Did you know there are **natural cures for high blood pressure** that are as effective as prescription drugs, and much safer? If you suffer from this condition, here is some information you will find interesting.

Many people aren't aware they have hypertension, because there are often no signs. Usually, the condition is spotted when going for a routine doctor visit. Prescription medications are prescribed, and life goes on. These drugs are often made of synthetic materials, and don't even treat the underlying cause of hypertension! Most people don't know this.

This is why using **natural cures to manage your high blood pressure** is so important. You can treat the cause, and improve your overall health – including other conditions like high cholesterol and diabetes symptoms. You also won't have the risky side effects some medications can cause.

There are many things you can do, and combining these methods will give the best results. Of course, you know there are certain things you should do such as reducing stress and cutting back on salt.

Here are some other tips for curing high blood pressure naturally:

1. Add certain foods to your diet. Foods containing potassium can cut blood pressure readings by as much as 20 points. Some foods packed with potassium are bananas, potatoes and tomatoes.
2. Magnesium - adding this nutrient to your diet is important as well. Magnesium and potassium work together in your body, and if your magnesium levels are low, most likely the potassium levels are as well. Foods that contain magnesium include oatmeal, yogurt and nuts.
3. Exercise - Adding light exercise can help dramatically. Simple walking or pilates exercise done 3 to 4 times per week for about 30 minutes is highly beneficial.
4. Vitamins and Herbs - There are certain vitamins and herbs that are essential for maintaining normal blood pressure. Some of these include folic acid and vitamin E.

These are just a few of the many natural cures for high blood pressure. There are literally hundreds of things you can do to bring your readings down by as much as 60 points in a very short length of time!

Wouldn't you love to feel better than you have in years, and improve your heart health tremendously? You can add years to your life by making some simple changes, and reduce your chances of developing other conditions.

As you can see in sample article #2, I used slight variations of the keyword phrase “natural cures for high blood pressure”. This is fine as well; I generally use the exact keyword phrase most often, and include a variation a time or two within the article.

Another thing you want to study in the articles – the first paragraph. In these paragraphs, I offer an introduction; in other words, I give the reader a clear idea of what I will be talking about in the article.

As you read the articles, notice how each paragraph or numbered topic revolves around a central idea. You want to avoid writing paragraphs where one idea runs in to another, as it can sound a bit strange and confusing if you jump from one thought to another in mid paragraph.

Tips to Help Make You a Better Writer

Writing good articles takes practice and research; I won't lie to you, your first article will probably not impress you too much. To get good at it, you have to learn how to do it and continue to write, just as you would any new job! As you go along and read what you have written, ideas will come to you on how to change what you have written so that it sounds better, more interesting, more valuable to the reader, etc. You will notice that your articles start to sound better, and that you are gaining confidence in your skills every day.

The best advice I can give you is to practice writing on topics you already know about at first. Visit the article sites where thousands of articles are published, and read! Pay attention to how the articles are written, how they are formatted, which ones you like and which you don't care too much for. In doing this, you can see the various styles used to write so that you can decide what's best for you. Over time, you will develop a writing style that is comfortable for you.

Remember that the internet is the largest source of information you will find; for any topic, simply search and you will find all of the articles and websites you need to research a topic so that you can write a good article. For example, say you are researching “how to lower cholesterol naturally”. Go to Google, Yahoo or your favorite search engine and simply type in those words. You will get tens or hundreds of thousands of results; just go to a few of the sites for your research.

After you have researched a few sites and read a few articles on the topic, you will be able to write a good article in your own words. Which brings up another point – NEVER plagiarize (copy someone else’s content). When you write for the websites listed above, they WILL check your article with Copyscape to make sure that it is original work.

Tools and Resources

You will want to keep this section of the book handy when you first begin writing! Here are some tools you can use to check spelling, word count and grammar:

[Word Count Tool](#) – Just copy your text into the box, then hit the submit button. The total number of words for that article will be displayed at the bottom.

[JSpell](#) – Free spell checker. Copy and paste your article in to the box; JSpell will then check spelling. If any words are misspelled, it will pop up a box of alternate words it believes you meant to use. Make corrections, then copy and paste back in to Notepad or Word, whichever application you are using to write your article.

[Spell Checker](#) – Spell Checker will check spelling and grammar, and give you alternate options that you may or may not want to use. If for some reason any of the above sites are not working, simply go to Google and key in "free spell checker", "free word counter", etc. There are several good ones out there!

Blogs are other great sources of information when you are researching a topic. In order to find blogs related to a topic you want to write about, just go to blogsearch.google.com and type in what you are looking for just as you would on Google or Yahoo.

There are literally millions of websites, blogs, and article directories online where you can research any topic so that you can write an informative, interesting article. I suggest that you do yourself a favor and write 2 or 3 articles every day for a few days to get the “hang” of things before you start signing up with the websites that I have listed above; you want to make the best possible impression, so that you do not get turned down as a writer.

Challenge to Get You Started

Okay, now you have all of this information and you're staring at the screen asking yourself “Where do I start?”. Here's a fun little challenge that will help you get your feet wet and motivate you.

Make a list of all of your hobbies, interests or passions. While you're making this list, write down anything that comes to mind. You can scratch things off later. This could be anything from cooking, scrapbooking, fashion, fishing, technical gadgets, shopping or raising teenagers to natural health, sports or pets.

After you have compiled your list, choose the ones you are really the most interested in. Once you have three or four of your favorites, go to the Google keyword tool at

<https://adwords.google.com/select/KeywordToolExternal>

Once there, key in one of your favorite hobbies or topics such as natural health. When you do, there will be a list of about 100 topics related to natural health, such as natural health remedies, natural health foods, and natural health supplements. Right off the bat, you've got three different articles you could right that are related to natural health!

Now, write three articles around whatever topic you chose after finding related keywords using the Google keyword tool. You don't have to get in a hurry, just do any research you need to do, then write good articles. Be sure to run a spelling and grammar check when completed.

Once you like what you see, submit these articles to Constant Content or Daily Article – *be sure to read their submission guidelines!* These sites allow you to set your own price – think of it them as “consignment shops” for your articles. When someone buys your article from the site, you make money!

Doing these types of little exercises will help you build confidence in your writing, so that you write lots of articles and make lots of money.

Final Thoughts

I really hope that you have found the websites, tips and information in this book helpful. As long as you let this book set on your computer and put off using it, you will not make any money. Put the information in this book in to action, and start your path to a highly profitable career that you can manage right from your own home!
